Starting pitch D

Sal - ly go round the sun.

As the children sing they should keep a beat by tapping right knee then left knee throughout and on the word BOOM clap! Different names can be used to replace Sally.



Everyone sings and walks in a circle to a steady beat whilst one child is in the centre with a drum. The child sings and plays the instrument very quietly and on the final word BOOM plays it really loudly! (The children in the circle jump around to fact the other way) If the child can walk and play the instrument, he should walk around the inside of the circle going the opposite direction to everyone else.

Make sure you are walking a steady beat – if it helps, march like a soldier and lift your knees really high!
