

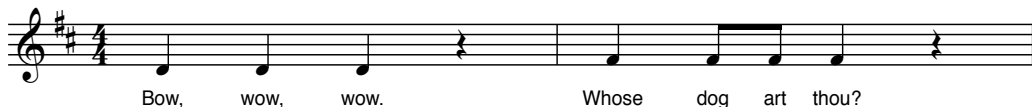


Bow, wow, wow: Song

BEAT

RHYTHM



Learn the actions in a pair.

1st bar: 1st beat: Clap own hands/2nd beat: Clap hands with partner/3rd beat: Clap own hands/4th beat: Jump 180 degrees around to face the other way.

2nd bar: 1st beat: Clap own hands/2nd beat: tap right knee then left knee/3rd beat: clap own hands/4th beat: Jump around to face partner again.

3rd bar: Hold hands and turn 180 degrees to change place

4th bar: As first bar.



The children are in a circle with everyone facing a partner. The actions are exactly as above but the game is continuous with the children having a new partner every time. Change the words adding the name of a child into the song e.g. *“Little Andrew Barton’s dog”*

Guess the song!



There are three rhythm patterns in the song **Bow wow wow**. One of the patterns is new the others are all in songs and rhymes we have done before. Look at the rhythm cards for **Bow wow wow**. Can you put them in the correct order? Can you think of other rhymes and songs you know which use these patterns?

*What would the form be for the four rhythm lines in Bow, wow, wow?
If we call the first pattern A then it would be A-B-C-A!*
