PITCH MATCHING

All Dog

Dog - gie, dog - gie where's your bone? Some-one stole it from my home!

5 All Thief

Who stole your dog - gie bone? I stole your dog - gie bone.



Guessing Game. The children sit in a circle. Introduce the song using two puppets – a dog and another puppet. All sing the first phrase to the dog who then “sings” the second phrase. All sing the third phrase to the dog and then the other puppet “sings” the final phrase. When the children know the song well, play the game. One child takes the dog puppet and sits in the middle of the circle with eyes closed. He is the guesser. As everyone sings the leader should give the other puppet to a chosen child in the circle who sings the final phrase. Everyone should put their hands behind his/her back before the dog opens his eyes. The dog should then guess who stole the bone.

Guess the song!



Are you listening to how high or low the song is sung? Make sure your voice **MATCHES** – just like two birds singing on a telegraph wire – they should both be at the same height.



Yes – we match!



*Whoops!
Too low!*



Always try to be like the two birds whose voices match – Don't sing the melody at a lower place or a higher place than anyone else!
